Policy for Anti-Ragging

Scope:

To prohibit an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness of a fresher or any other student.

Objectives:

To prohibit any conduct by any students to student, whose act adversely affects the physique or psyche of freshers or any other students, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, or any act of physical or mental abuse targeted at another student on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background and thereby, to eliminate ragging.

To prohibit misconduct by any student or students by words spoken or written.

To prohibit an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness of a fresher or any other student.

To prohibit students from indulging in any indisciplined activities.

To stop conduct of any activity likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or raise fear or apprehension thereof in the mind of any fresher or any other student asking any student to do any such act which such student will not in the ordinary course do so and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame.

To stop showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student; and thereby, to eliminate ragging in all its forms in the college premises by prohibiting it under these regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided in this Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

Guidelines:

During admission, an undertaking is obtained from the Parent/Guardian that their ward will not indulge in any ragging or abet such in disciplined activities.

A separate undertaking regarding anti- ragging is obtained from the students at the time of admission.

Consequences of indulging in ragging or in any indisciplined activities shall be explained to the students while addressing the induction or orientation program at the beginning of every academic classes/semester.

Pictures and posters which enlighten about punishment for ragging shall be conspicuously displayed in the college campus.

The students shall be educated about the prevailing anti-ragging laws and the imminent punishment for violation.

All the teaching and non-teaching staff shall be adequately educated about the menace of ragging in the college campus and to ensure such incidents shall be brought to the notice of the institution forthwith, once it comes to their knowledge.

An Anti-ragging squad and a monitoring committee in the college to prevent ragging and to have a periodical review of steps taken towards the same shall be formed.

Stringent action shall be initiated against those students, who are found guilty of such violation, depending upon the nature of the offence, namely

- Suspension from attending the classes.
- Debarring from representing the institution.

The information about the complaints received on ragging will be kept confidential.
