Students suggested to maintain the desks and benches without getting dust.



Girls students want to have the first bell to be advanced by two minutes to the present time of 9.25am.

3. Switch boards in all class rooms should be repaired so that video session and ppt classes may be conducted without any hindrance.













4. During Summative Examinations, college bus facility should be provided to all possible routes.




