Infrastructure

There are 23 buses plying for the benefit of the students. There are 92 non-teaching staff to administer the day-to-day proceedings of the college effectively. The non-teaching faculty are also updating their knowledge by undergoing various courses.

The Directorate of Distance Education of Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai, conducts MBA course on our premises. A separate hostel with well equipped rooms is provided for the students of Sri Kaliswari Institute of Management & Technology.

From 2nd May, 2013, the Department of English organized a 15 day Summer Crash Course for school children. Thirty students from classes VI to XII from various schools attended this course and were benefitted. (Revenue earned Rs.8,125/-).

- Leased line Internet connection provided to all PG departments, Language Lab, Hotel Management & Catering Science, boys' hostel and girl's hostel.
- Separate Internet Lab is available for both teaching and non-teaching faculties. Teaching faculty use the Internet facilities free of cost to prepare their study materials and for their research activities.
- Non-teaching faculty also use the Internet facilities free of cost for their higher studies.
- All the UG and PG students use the Internet at a nominal cost of Rs.10/- per hour.
- Research scholars also use Internet free of cost.
